## **COMPLIANCE DECLARATION**

on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances established by **EU DIRECTIVE 2011/65** (RoHS 2), amended by **EU DIRECTIVE 2015/863** on March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2015.

ESSEGI SYSTEM SERVICE SRL, with registered office located in via Zambon 14-16, 36051, Creazzo, Vicenza, Italy, legally represented by Alessandro Bilato, hereby declares to have read and understood the provisions of the European DIRECTIVE 2011/65 for the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS 2).

ESSEGI SYSTEM SERVICE SRL hereby declares that all its supplied products comply with the aforementioned European DIRECTIVE for the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances, particularly with article 4 paragraph 1, which establishes maximum concentration values tolerated by weight in homogeneous materials in electrical and electronic equipment as follows:

Hexavalent Chromium and its compounds	0,1% by weight in the homogeneous material	(1g/Kg-1000ppm)
Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) 0,1%	0,1% by weight in the homogeneous material	(1g/Kg-1000ppm)
Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) 0,1%	0,1% by weight in the homogeneous material	(1g/Kg-1000ppm)
Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) 0,1%	0,1% by weight in the homogeneous material	(1g/Kg-1000ppm)
Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP) 0,1%	0,1% by weight in the homogeneous material	(1g/Kg-1000ppm)
Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) 0,1%	0,1% by weight in the homogeneous material	(1g/Kg-1000ppm)
Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) 0,1%	0,1% by weight in the homogeneous material	(1g/Kg-1000ppm)

<sup>\*</sup> Homogeneous material: a material of uniform composition throughout or a material, consisting of a combination of materials, that cannot be disjointed or separated into different materials by mechanical actions such as unscrewing, cutting, crushing, grinding and abrasive processes.

## Exemptions to the RoHS Directive:

- To the equipment necessary for the protection of essential interests in the field of security and defense of member states, including weapons, ammunition, and military equipment intended for specifically military purposes;
- To the equipment intended to be sent into space;
- To devices specifically designed to be installed as parts of another piece of equipment,
